

 - ► Accomodation in ecolodge in Simal (with pool)










- ▶ Day 4

 - ► Returning to the ecolodge in Simal








- ▶ Day 5

 - ► Return to the ecolodge






- ▶ Day 8

Concrete information

- Insurance (optional, but highly recommended)
 - All risk insurance 7% of sum (cancellation, repatriation, unexpected changes,...)

- Vaccinations
 - ▶ Belgian ministry of foreign affairs: yellow fever, tetanus, malaria,...
 - Check with your doctor!
- Passport valid for 6 months after trip
 - Belgian nationals: No visa required
 - Others: Check with the Senegalese embassy
 - Wait for confirmation of trip going ahead before requesting
